Meeting was brought to order by the President @ approximately 19:05 hrs.

Minutes from the Board of Directors meetings and previous AGM minutes were distributed by email prior to the meeting.

- AGM minutes August 9, 2021

As the April 23, 2023, and June 08, 2023, minutes were from a WDRG board of directors meeting the President asked if there were any errors or omissions and hearing none made a motion to accept the minutes of the 23 April and 08 June 2023, Mark Blumm, seconded the motion, all members approved. The AGM minutes dated August 8, 2021, were also distributed to all members prior to the meeting and the President asked the members if there were any errors or omissions and on hearing none made a motion to accept the minutes and seconded by the Treasurer, all members approved.

Financial report by the Treasurer was provided and a discussion took place that WDRG will set up a \$200.00 self-insurance fund for 2023 and 2024 year. A motion was made by the President to accept these additions and seconded by the Secretary; all members approved.

Budget the President mentioned that the only items that are budgeted now is the club's RAC Insurance and the club's annual return.

Current issues – Motion for the WAN group to merge with MRS, as the motion had previously been made and seconded at the WDRG board of directors meeting on June 8, 2023. The WDRG members voted unanimously in favor of the WAN group merging with MRS.

Year end – The President provided a summary of the following:

 The dStar repeater had the antenna mounting bolts come loose and were fixed. The gateway computer is being worked on by William – VE4VR.

- The VE4DMR repeater has been moved to 55 Nassau Street due power and internet issues at the Osborne site. All DMR repeaters are now Hytera models, and we have the Motorola 8400 as a back up repeater.
- On November 2, 2022, our club sold one of our Motorola 8400 repeaters to the Brandon Radio Club and we helped with the installation.
- On or around December 23, 2022, the VE4DMR repeater suffered a catastrophic failure due to a power spike of some nature and damaged the elevator circuits and other major systems at 601 Osborne Street. Our backup DMR repeater was installed and shortly after the installation we found out that certain brands of radios do not work with the Motorola repeater. We can only determine that this is because DMR is originally a commercial system, and since the Motorola repeater is a commercial repeater, we belief the build quality/tolerances of the cheaper radios do not match with the quality of the commercial Motorola repeater. The cost to repair the Motorola repeater was \$576.80 and thanks to the WAN group for helping with the cost.

Committee Reports - Dan Kiezer

 Provided an update on our membership and mentioned that our group membership is down from last year.

Unfinished Business - The President

asked about the MMDVM project and William VE4VR mentioned that he is working
on part on it and asked if the group thought of setting up the backup DMR repeater
and using it rather than having it sit somewhere not used. Discussion took place on
various scenarios, locations etc. Rob brought up about setting up a Fusion (C4FM)
repeater and setting it up to talk with Brandmeister network so that we can talk
across the systems. It was mentioned to possibly selling the Motorola 8400 and buy
Hytera repeaters. William asked what is being done with the MMDVM/Pie project as
he has some radios and put together a mobile repeater for all modes and put it at
601 Osborne St.

Further work on the project is possible in the new year.

Moving the 1.2 GHz data module to U of M and William mentioned that the there was
nothing happening there (U of M) as it's been over a year and no approval processes
done. Lots of good discussion where to locate elsewhere or leave it. It was decided
to leave it in place and connect it up for use in the future.

- Derek was not nominated as he did not meet the eligibility requirements of paragraph 117(1)(a)¹ & (b)² along with paragraph (2)³ of the Corporations Act of Manitoba.
- Derek asked how he did not meet the requirements and was told by the Nomination Committee chair that because of what he had done with the leases for 601 Osborne, 60 Chesterfield Road, 529 Country Club Road, 215 Eaton Street. He had also signed lease agreements for Neepawa, Minnedosa, Brandon, Dauphin, and Souris as the Vice President⁴ and the President had signed. Further explanations mentioned that the Secretary must sign all deeds and contracts. Derek had solely signed the other lease agreements when he had no authority to sign them by himself.
